

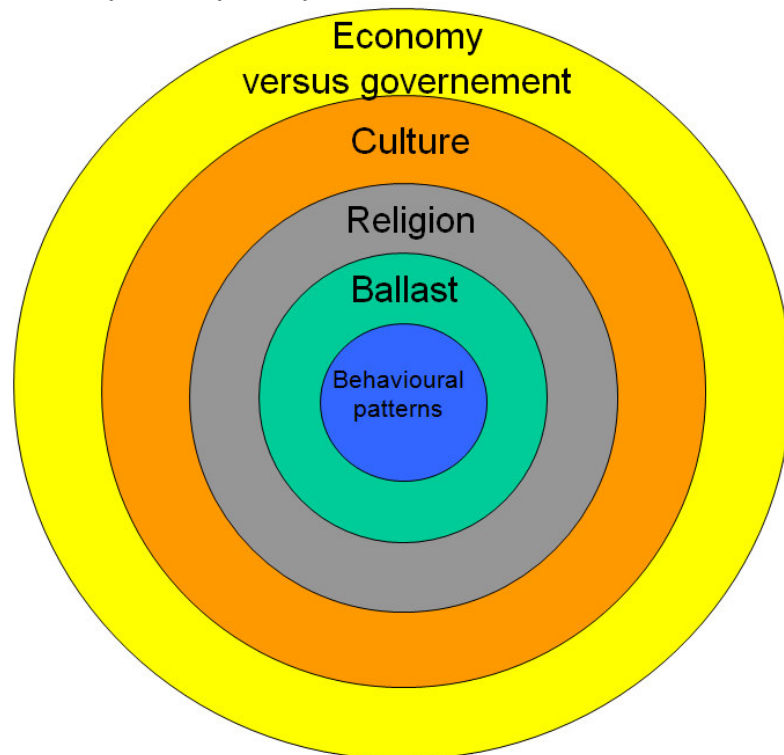
What are “The Circles”?

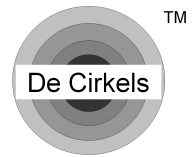
Information descends today to everyone in enormous quantities through several canals. Nearly everyone stores this information based on existing ideas, judgements and convictions. This is what we call ballast. The way this ballast has come about is crucial because it determines the behavioral patterns of people.

The Circles give insight into *who* exerts influence on the general/global/large-scale/cultural shaping of ideas, judgements and convictions. This ballast has been imposed from the Circles of Religion, Culture and Economic System versus Government. Every person speaks, judges and argues, to a certain extent influenced by these circles. Working with the questioning methods ensures that people get insight in the content of their own circles. Then every person can make the choice if they themselves stipulate how their behavioral patterns are, or they leave this to other people to decide this for them.

It is also the way to see coherence between ongoing developments since the beginning of the history like governments, economy, religion, culture, environment and the development of the earth’s surface. The key to these insights is the largest freedom people posses: “The freedom to ask questions”.

Every circle has been developed in detail and you can choose to gain insight in the ballast you carry with you.





Functioning of The Circles

People clash frequently against their own circles without having insight into their existence. Because it is a circle, there is no escape possible. Often are people getting tired of clashing and they become bitter or disappointed. Do we have to fight ourselves through the circles? No, you can ascend your circles by asking the right questions. The well-known helicopter view! ☺ You look at yourself and you get insight into why you have fixed ideas, judgements and convictions.

Time

To absorb information costs time, answering the questions costs time, to deepen yourself in the power struggle between the powers groups costs time. How much time do we have after work, social obligations, children, sports, traffic-jams and the planning of the remaining leisure time? Everyone can decide for him or herself the time they are willing to spend to get insight into the world in which we live. Researching information, preferably in association with others, is essential for obtaining insight.

Research

Information from media provides contemporary questions which can be examined with the questioning method provided per each circle. Researching this information enables every person to get insight in the background of power groups' decisions in a country and how they influence the lives of all the people. This reveals the actual objectives of these power groups and their methods to reach them.

Cooperation

The Circles wants to support this by enabling people to start communities where they execute mutual research to discover the truth, separate from indoctrination or imposed ideas. Everyone must critically review information found. This is possible by asking questions, by following your feeling if the information is correct or by following developments. Everyone can form his or her own opinion concerning the current direction of their society.

Questioning method per circle

There is for every circle a basis set of questions under construction. These have to be refined and are therefore not yet published. The overall aim is to gain insights into how and why decisions concerning current topics in a society are made. These decisions show the objectives of corporations, political parties and religions. This shapes our ballast and, as a result, influences our behavioral patterns.
